

Frequently Asked Questions about Enrollment at Pioneer Meadows Montessori School

What are the steps for applying?

We ask our prospective families to first attend an Information Night and then come in for an Observation.

How do I find out about Prospective Parent Meeting Dates?

We host monthly Prospective Parent Meetings during the school year beginning in November. Director of Education, Ellen Lebitz, gives an overview of the Montessori philosophy, as well as a tour of the school and a "question and answer" session for prospective parents. This is the first step in our Admission process. After attending a meeting, you may then sign up for an observation.

What are your Tuition and Fees?

2011-2012 Tuition and Fees are posted on our website (and included in our initial information packet). Please refer to the 2011-2012 Tuition and Fees. Tuition fees typically rise anywhere from 1 to 3% each year to keep up with rising costs.

Do you have a Waiting List?

We have an ongoing Applicant Pool. Openings in a Montessori classroom are age and gender specific; therefore, our first consideration is what openings we are able to offer each school year. We meet prospective primary (preschool) students during our interview sessions held later in the school year.

How do I get my child into the Applicant Pool?

Attending a Prospective Parent Meeting is the first step. After attending a meeting we ask you to observe in an age appropriate classroom while it's in session. Both of these steps are adult only events. Both steps are required in the Admission process.
